Northland's largest city, Whangārei, is a vibrant community with a population of 91,000. Whāngarei is popular for its beautiful harbour, unique Hundertwasser Art Centre, exciting and interactive community events and vibrant shopping precincts. Many schools are walking distance to the Whangarei CBD, Town Basin and Loop Walk. Kerikeri township in the Bay of Islands has a population of 10,000 and is known for it's outdoor lifestyle with access to beaches and coastline for sailing, surfing, kayaking, paddleboarding and swimming as well as native forest with picturesque walks and waterfalls. Kerikeri has schools within walking distance to the township and shopping area and in a rural location just outside of town

Northland is only a two-hour drive from New Zealand's largest city, Auckland (population 1.6 million), and is surrounded by beautiful coastlines. Northland offers a chance to learn to surf, go horse riding along a beach, go camping or explore the 144 islands in the Bay of Islands.







A world-class education with endless opportunities

New Zealand is recognised as having one of the world's best education systems, with high quality teachers delivering internationally recognised qualifications. Northland schools offer NCEA (National Certificate of Education Achievement) and Cambridge.

New Zealand's education system focuses on teaching students to solve problems, absorb, analyse and apply information, to work with others to create and innovate. Students enjoy hands-on learning and the system supports debate, free thinking and flexibility. Our teachers encourage students to be confident, connected and actively involved, lifelong learners.

As well as a strong focus on academic excellence, schools encourage students to excel in other areas such as music, the arts and sport. We strive to prepare our students for future success, and offer tailored programmes for our international students to suit individual abilities and interests. New Zealand's standard national secondary school qualification, the NCEA, is recognised by tertiary institutions in New Zealand and around the world. In addition, private schools in Northland such as Springbank School and Huanui College offer the International Cambridge Curriculum.

Pastoral care is equally important for our international students. All Northland schools hosting international students are signatories to the Education (Pastoral Care of Tertiary & International Learners) Code of Practice 2021, which ensures we take a holistic approach to the social, emotional and educational wellbeing of all of our students. Every student is well supported within the school environment, and we also ensure every student has a safe, warm home environment with a New Zealand homestay family or with our school boarding facilities. Our education system is built on the New Zealand

Qualifications Framework (NZQF), which is a comprehensive list of all quality-assured qualifications in New Zealand.

All qualifications listed on the NZQF have been approved by the New Zealand Qualifications Authority or Universities New Zealand as being high quality, relevant and fit for the purpose of education. At a tertiary level, students can gain internationallyrecognised qualifications at NorthTec | Te Pūkenga, Northland's largest tertiary education provider, offering more than 100 programmes ranging from foundation to degree level. For students interested in graduating in New Zealand, Northland also offers unique employment opportunities with a growing number of jobs in nursing and hospitality jobs. Graduates are also needed in industries that make the most of Northland's abundant natural resources, such as agriculture, horticulture, forestry and fishing. There are also jobs available in boat building, marine engineering, construction, health, education, law, accountancy, manufacturing, IT and the petrochemical sector. New Zealand's business hub, Auckland, is just a two-hour commute away.

Cape Reinga

At the very top of Northland is Cape Reinga, where you can witness the spectacular meeting of the Pacific Ocean and the Tasman Sea. Cape Reinga is also a very sacred place for Māori – according to oral history, the spirits of deceased Māori depart from Cape Reinga to return to their ancestral homeland.

Waitangi

Waitangi is culturally significant to New Zealand, as the place where the Treaty of Waitangi between Māori and the Europeans was first signed. Waitangi is a place of special cultural significance to all New Zealanders, and offers an excellent opportunity to learn about New Zealand's history.

Bay of Islands

The beautiful Bay of Islands is one of New Zealand's most spectacular destinations with over 140 sub-tropical islands in a sheltered harbour. Due to its climate, it is a world-famous sailing destination. Visitors can also enjoy the many beaches, exploring the islands, fishing, dolphin watching, kayaking and para sailing.

Kerikeri

Kerikeri is the largest town in the Bay of Islands with a population of 10,000. It has several fitness centres, a cinema complex and an events centre. It is known for its many cafes, art galleries and interesting shops as well as being famous for growing citrus and kiwi fruit. Kerikeri has many cultural and historic attractions including the iconic Stone Store, Te Ahurea (traditional Māori village) and Kororipo Pā overlooking the Kerikeri river.

Whangārei

Whangārei is Northland's largest city, with 91,000 residents enjoying a relaxed multi-cultural community where creativity is celebrated. The compact city centre offers everything you could need, including a great selection of cafes, restaurants, and shops, while Whangarei's rural and coastal districts showcase the city's stunning scenery.

Whangārei is just a two hour drive from Auckland, and there are regular flights and buses from Auckland to Whangarei and Kerikeri, with a flight to Whangārei taking just 30 minutes and Kerikeri just 45 minutes.

UNIQUE FEATURES & PROGRAMMES

Whangārei Primary School has a very strong and well resourced "English for Speakers of Other Languages" (E.S.O.L.) department, which aims to support our international and migrant students to learn through a holistic and integrated curriculum. We have specialist teachers for Te Reo Māori and Music, and we have a strong values based programme running through the school.

EDUCATIONAL HIGHLIGHTS

Whangārei Primary School has revisioned over the past 18 months and our new slogan is "Dare to be Remarkable." We follow the New Zealand Curriculum, which is currently undergoing a "Refresh", and we are strong advocates of "Relationship Based learning" where teachers develop strong learning-focused relationships with students and whanau and then use evidence-based teaching strategies to ensure strong academic and holistic achievement. Our school values of Care, Courage, Respect and Responsibility play an integral part in the holistic education of our children.

CULTURAL HIGHLIGHTS

Whangārei Primary School ensures that all cultures are valued and celebrated; we recognise that individuals need to feel part of our team by having their heritage, culture and background accepted and respected. Each term students lead a whole school powhiri for new students and staff to the school. This is an important part of who we are at Whangārei Primary School, and whanau are invited to join the Manuhiri (guests) so that we can welcome students and family into our kura (school) to become Tangata Whenua (people of our land). The school has three Kapa Haka groups that

perform regularly throughout the year at assemblies, powhiri, concerts and festivals. The whole school practises waiata (Māori songs) every fortnight to ensure thorough preparation for powhiri.

SPORTING HIGHLIGHTS

Our school runs hockey and netball teams that compete after school and on weekends. We have strong links to Northland Cricket, Football, Rugby and Hockey and receive regular specialist coaching for these sports at school. We have a fabulous 250m bike track and Northland Bike Ready comes into our school to give specialist riding tuition. We have camps for all students from Year 3 upwards, and have day trips for extracurricular activities like sailing, surfing, environmental science and museum trips.

SPECIAL FACILITIES

The school grounds have a sports field, a large swimming pool (33m long), an all weather sports turf and a basketball and netball court planned for the front playground. Our new building, Te Whare Raikia O Ngā Manu (the flocking place of the birds), has recently been built to house the teaching of Music and Te Reo Māori - it is a functional, flexible working space which is adorned with amazing colours and vibrant murals. E-learning is integrated throughout the school at increasing levels relative to the age group - in most classes we have a 1:2 student to device ratio. We also have an extensive ESOL programme, which runs daily for our foreign language students.
